## Children, Worship, & Learning

**Editor's Note:** The following article is edited for relevance specific to RLC and includes excerpts from a resource written by Miriam Campbell, available in its entirety online at <http://archive.elca.org/christianeducation/discipleship/childrenworship.html>.

**Children are important members of our congregations.** "We receive you as fellow members of the body of Christ, children of the same heavenly Father, and workers with us in the kingdom of God."

**Worship is an important part of what the Body of Christ does.** "Children learn especially by example and by trying things out. Inviting children to participate is the most powerful way to teach them. Guiding children in worship passes on to them a heritage of language and image and gesture by which they can then form their own approach to God. It is a gift they will be able to draw upon throughout the course of their lives. It is a gift which includes the clear message that they are absolutely integral to the community of faith."

Children also learn the following in worship: they belong to Christ . . . music and art as expressions of praise and human responses to God are appropriate, enriching, and valued . . . God's gathered people hear and interpret stories from the Bible . . . worship is one place where God may speak to them . . . they are not only a part of a local faith community, but are also a part of the entire church of Christ.

### Preparing Children for Worship

**Show your child the Lord's Prayer** in the Bible (Matthew 6:9-13) or in Luther's Small Catechism. Discuss the meaning of each petition. Pray the Lord's Prayer together.

Guiding children in worship passes on to them a heritage of language and image and gesture by which they can then form their own approach to God.

**Pray at home** for family, friends, work, school, needs of others beyond your neighborhood, and events of your congregation.

**Read the scripture passages** for the next Sunday at home during the week. Talk about themes that you might hear and see on Sunday.

**Read the Words of Institution in the Bible** (I Corinthians 11:23-25) or in Luther's Small Catechism. Discuss what Holy Communion means and what happens during worship.

### Session 3 Mary Among the Disciples

Mary may well have been a widowed single woman when she is called to a new role as a mature leader in the early church. We will look at the poignant moment when Jesus entrusts his beloved disciple into Mary's care, along with a final glimpse of Mary joining the disciples in visioning and prayer.

## *Before Worship*

**Encourage children to include their prayer requests** to yellow worship slips.

**Ask for a children's bulletin.** Also begin to acquaint them with regular bulletins.

**Encourage children to use their soft voice** as soon as they enter the sanctuary.

**Comment on special events in worship** such as a baptism, new members joining, a special day in life of the congregation, and changes in the church seasons and colors. Look around and discuss new banners or other visual changes in the sanctuary. Discuss symbols also.

## *During Worship*

**Assist children** during the service. Make sure they have the right page for hymns. Point out words to help them understand and participate. Let young children know when a part they are familiar with is coming. They can respond with "Hear our prayer," "Thanks be to God," and say all or part of the Lord's Prayer, for example.

**Encourage children to take part in Children's Church.** Accompany them if they are timid.

**Help children participate** in giving to the life of the congregation by making sure they have their own offerings, regardless of the amount.

**Sit close to the front** of the sanctuary. Children are able to participate more fully when they can see what is happening. Provide pencil, crayons, and paper for drawing. Don't be surprised if you see symbols of the church in their drawings as they listen to what is being said around them. Hand activity can actually help them concentrate and reflect on what they experience in worship.

**Pick up an activity bag in the Cry Room** for young children to use only during worship.

## *After Worship*

**Walk around the sanctuary** to look more closely at the font, the altar, banners, windows, etc. Encourage your children to greet others as you stay for fellowship, prepare for Sunday school, or leave to return home. Talk with your child about what he/she heard, saw, did, and felt during worship. Make worship a regular part of the time you spend with your child. Let God's love be evident in your family life the rest of the week.

**Sunday evenings at 5:00 PM** we have an informal communion service in the chapel. Geared for families with small children, the service is very simple, and we have more of an interactive sermon that begins with a children's object lesson and expands into a discussion. There are no stretches where children need to "sit still and listen." The Lord's Prayer is the topic we are exploring this summer.

## Men's Ministry Updates

"Men! Here is the feedback we received from the Men's Ministry survey that was conducted last fall:

- We received about 7% responses out of the 350 men in our congregation (we encourage [all men](#) interested in submitting a survey to do so at any time --- they are available in the narthex)
- The majority of respondents describe their spiritual journey as a "growing relationship with Christ", which the Men's Ministry hopes to facilitate.
- We plan to increase our congregation's awareness, and better inform our men of the Men's Ministry activities and opportunities. 83% of the respondents said that they are aware of Men's Ministry activities or opportunities, and 74% said that they have been adequately informed, but we want to do better.
- The Men's Ministry responded to the interest expressed in a golf activity with a fun golf scrambler on Tuesday, May 5. It was well attended, and there are plans to hold another this year. Thanks to Art Kranz for organizing this event! Other events that scored high amongst RLC men on the survey include: retreats, men's night out program, wood working group, sporting events, fishing outing, bicycling, sweetheart banquet, and adventure travel (including skiing). Keep a look out for these events in the future! **...And let us know if you are interested in helping to lead a function!**
- There was a lot of interest in these spiritual topics that we will look to incorporate into our studies and other activities: Being a better husband, serving, maintaining a strong family relationship, prayer, being a Christian in the workplace, gifts of the Holy Spirit, discovering God's will for our lives, and quiet time.

Thank you all for taking the time to give us your input! It is very valuable. We learned a lot more about you and about what we can do to better serve you. ## *Parish Nursing Notes—Heat Wave Safety tips*

Summer heat waves can be dangerous. Older people are at the highest risk. People normally cool their bodies by sweating, but under some conditions, sweating isn't enough. Very high body temperatures may damage the brain or other vital organs. Some conditions that can limit the ability to regulate temperature include old age, obesity, fever, dehydration, heart disease, poor circulation, sunburn, and drug and alcohol use. Summertime activity, whether on the playing field or the construction site, must be done in a way to aid the body's cooling mechanisms and prevent heat-related illness. To protect yourself when temperatures are extremely high:

- Drink Plenty of Fluid
- Replace Salt and Minerals
- Wear Appropriate Clothing and Sunscreen
- Slow Down
- Pace Yourself
- Stay Cool Indoors
- Schedule Outdoor Activities Carefully
- Use a Buddy System
- Monitor Those at High Risk
- Adjust to the Environment
- Use Common Sense

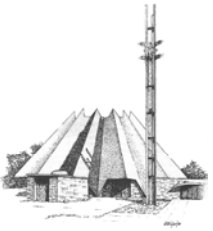
